**REMEMBER THIS?**

**The Air Accidents Investigation Branch (AAIB) is calling for a  
comprehensive review of ground safety at Heathrow <sup>1</sup>**

The AAIB tells us that the recent Heathrow Jumbo's landing error 'posed minimal risk.'

Well that's OK then isn't it? The Government and the aviation industry can go ahead with a 3<sup>rd</sup> runway at Heathrow can't they? It will only result in a 42% increase in flights. And it doesn't matter does it that the 'Civil Aviation Authority's Directorate of Airspace Policy (DAP) ... has not been involved in any statistical analysis of the risk of a major incident in the event of an additional runway at Heathrow. This has been confirmed at senior management level within the Directorate.'<sup>i</sup>

We're only talking of an extra 100,000 West Londoners being overflowed aren't we? And our centre of Government being overflowed and the residence of our monarch – but that's OK isn't it?

Will they never learn? How many people's lives are being put at risk by these expansionist aviation dreams?

Christine Shilling, NoTRAG Press Secretary says Heathrow Airport must not be allowed to expand outside its existing boundaries. The consequences are too unthinkable in human terms to ever contemplate.
